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## 1. Overview

This document provides an overview of APIIDA support services, as well as contact information and best practices for collaboration.

## 2. APIIDA Support- and Maintenance services

APIIDA offers the following support and maintenance services:

### APIIDA Standard Support

As part of Standard Support, we provide support and maintenance services for APIIDA AG products. Customers with an active maintenance and support contract can avail support for the products defined therein.

APIIDA Standard Support includes:

- APIIDA Online Support
- Access to our support team by phone and e-mail during our defined support hours (see 3)
- Software updates, bug fixes and patches for licensed products

### Support for Non-APIIDA Products

Depending on the respective contractual regulation, we also provide support services for products of other manufacturers. The manufacturer is responsible for providing updates, bug fixes and patches.



## APIIDA Enhanced Support Services

## 4. Severity levels and response times

Reported incidents are prioritized and handled based on severity. Severity levels provide an indication of the urgency and impact of the reported case. A reported incident is also reviewed by our support team for severity and adjusted if necessary to give the incident a suitable priority.

Severity (and Priority)	Description	Response time*
1 (Highest)	<p><b>Operation preventing (critical) fault</b> Availability of the contractual basis is not given, while the operation is interrupted or prevented or can no longer be executed.</p> <p><u>Examples:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>▪ Total failure of core components</li><li>▪ Business processes are critically affected</li></ul>	2 hours

<b>2 (High)</b>	<b>Operational obstruction</b> Availability of the contractual basis is negatively affected, the operational sequence is not fully usable in its function, individual functions have failed.  <u>Examples:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Basic functionalities are still available</li> <li>▪ Business processes are noticeably affected</li> </ul>	4 hours
<b>3 (Medium)</b>	<b>Slightly dysfunctional disturbance</b> Availability of the contractual basis is impaired, while the operation is still largely functional.  <u>Examples:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Slow processing</li> <li>▪ Necessary multiple re-start (manual)</li> <li>▪ Fault in incremental operation</li> </ul>	1 Working Day
<b>4 (Low)</b>	<b>Slight disorder</b> Availability of the contractual basis might be slightly reduced, but the use and usability are given. Malfunctions can be bypassed, or the usability has only worsened.  <u>Examples:</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Functions not limited or only slightly limited</li> <li>▪ General question about the product</li> </ul>	2 Working Days

## 5. Reporting an incident

The following information should help you to get started using our support portal and help you report an incident. The following sections provide basic information and illustrations.

To communicate effectively, it is also necessary to name a certain number of contacts who should be given the right to open tickets with APIIDA support. These contacts are your interface to our support team and should have adequate technical knowledge to enable an effective collaboration.

In general, we need the following information for an effective processing of your inquiry:

- What product/solution is affected? What version and release?
- Which OS/platform does it run on (for non-SaaS offerings)?
- Concise description of the incident
- Can the incident be reproduced and how?
- What effect does the incident have (priority - see above severity levels)?
- Already existing findings through first analysis on your part

- Additional information such as log files, screenshots and the like

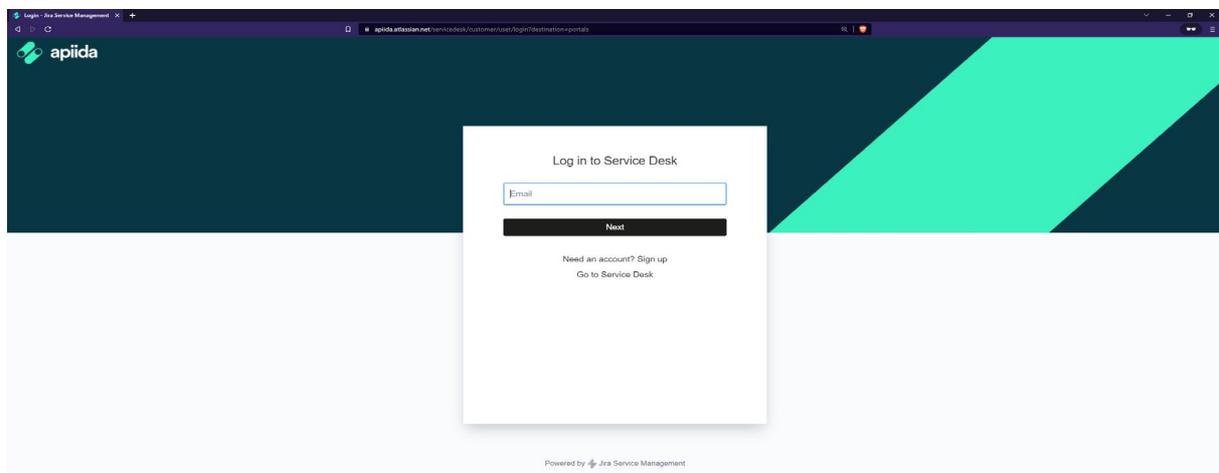
## Creating a ticket via our Webportal

Customers with an active maintenance and support contract receive an email that contains login information as well as a link. This link leads to the registration page of our support portal and you will be asked to define a password for access to the support portal.

To register, please enter the credentials you provided during registration. The following screen shows a successful registration.

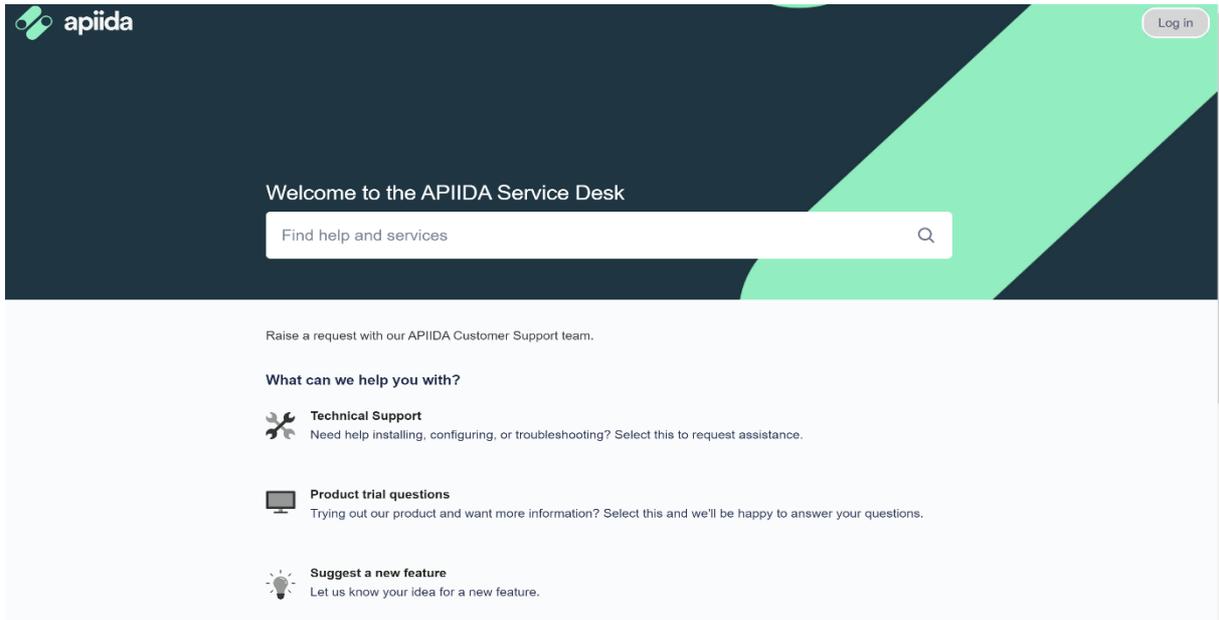


Illustration 2: Webportal Overview

Hereinafter, the above mask will be described in more detail.

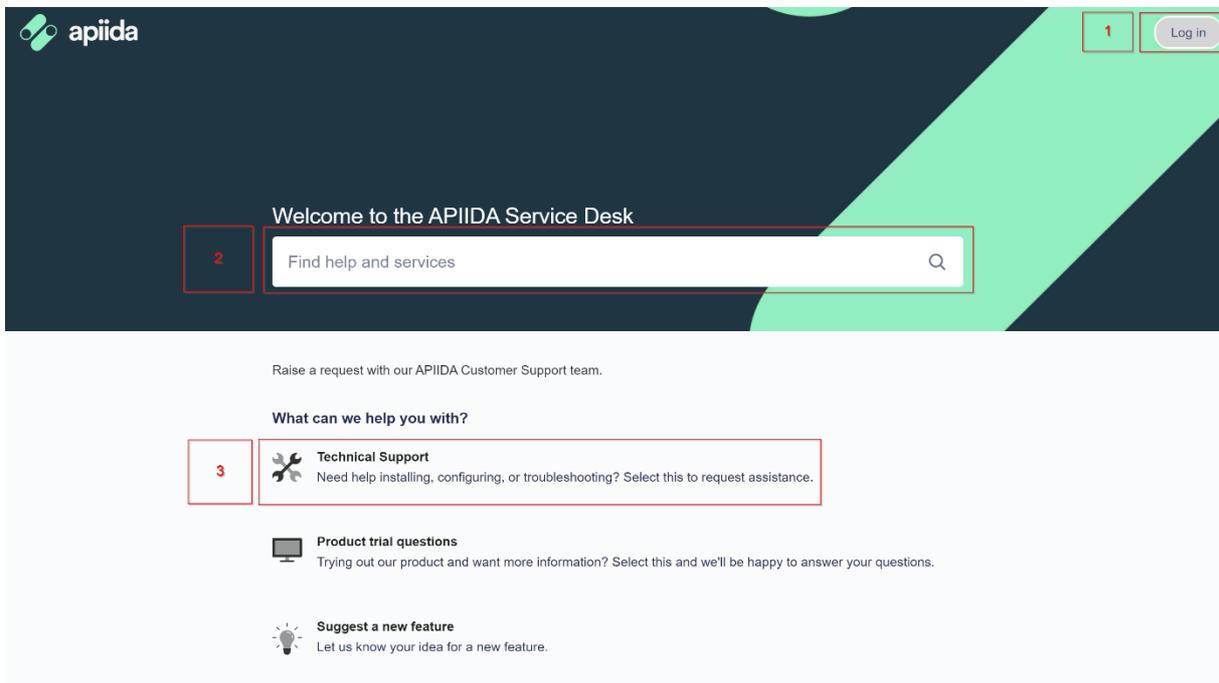


Illustration 3: Webportal on Overview

### Essential functions:

- 1 - Queries can be viewed here and also settings for the user profile can be changed. You may also change your password.
- 2 - This search field allows you to search the Knowledge Base before creating a ticket.
- 3 - This link gives you the opportunity to report an incident. This will be described below.

To open a ticket, click on the link "Technical Support". Then the following input mask opens:

**Description of the individual input fields:**

- 1 – Category: The request type can be adjusted here.
- 2 – Component: This optional selection can be used to associate the incident with a specific product. Therefore, if necessary, the product to be used can be selected here.
- 3 – Priority: The incident to be reported can be given a priority here. Our support team will review these and make any adjustments, based on the contract and its contents.
- 4 – Summary: Please enter a short description.
- 5 – Description: The description should clearly show the incident to be reported. Information that describes how the error can be reproduced, and log files that provide additional information are important.
- 6 – Attachment: Here additional information supporting our analysis can be attached. These can be, for example, logfiles and screenshots.
- 7 – Create: Clicking this button completes the process of creating a ticket.
